### **Our Mission**

To assist the senior citizens in the Loveland area to live interesting and full lives so that they may continue to contribute, participate and share in the life of the community.

Additionally, the responsibilities of the board include the following:

1. To serve as coordinating agency for senior services and activities.
2. To assess, publicize and support present senior services and activities in the community.
3. To investigate and evaluate requests for new senior citizen services and activities.
4. To plan, initiate, develop and encourage new senior programs as need is indicated.
5. To establish and maintain communications with local, state and federal government agencies concerning senior citizens.

### **Who are We?**

Senior Advisory Board members are connected to our community in many ways. The Board has a City Council member who serves as liaison between the Council and our Board. One member is Staff Liaison to commissions and boards of Loveland city government. Other members have roles at the Office on Aging, Chilson Senior Advisory Committee and local healthcare and housing facilities.

### **Senior Advocacy**

To be informed advocates, the Senior Advisory Board regularly participates in community events, such as Bridging the Gap for Seniors, Silver Tsunami seminars, Senior Day at the Capitol, and Senior Law Day at Colorado State University.
