Long Lankin by Lindsey Barraclough

When Cora and her younger sister, Mimi, are sent to stay with their great Auntie Ida in an isolated village in 1958, they discover that they are in danger from a centuries-old evil and strive to uncover the horrifying truth before it is too late.

Darkwater by Catherine Fisher

Sarah sells her soul to reclaim her family's estate and is given 100 years to atone for their sins. As the bargain nears its end, Tom, yearning to attend the private school that Darkwater Hall has become, gets caught up in the bargain.

Scowler by Daniel Kraus

In the midst of a meteor shower, a homicidal maniac escapes from prison and returns to the farm where his nineteen-year-old son, Ry, must summon three childhood toys - Mr. Furrington, Jesus Christ, and Scowler - to protect himself.

Mountain of Bones by Christopher Krovatin

During a class trip three kids become separated from their backpacking group in the Montana wilderness and discover they are stranded in the heart of zombie country.

The End Games by T. Michael Martin

In the rural mountains of West Virginia, Michael tries to protect his fragile younger brother from the horrors of the zombie apocalypse by battling monsters in The Game.

Asylum by Madeleine Roux

Three teens at a summer program for gifted students uncover shocking secrets in the sanatorium-turned-dorm where they're staying. Secrets that link them all to the asylum's dark past.

Henry Franks by Peter Adam Salomon

While a serial killer stalks his small Georgia town, sixteen-year-old Henry tries to find the truth about the terrible accident that robbed him of his mother and his memories, and left him with 4,317 stitches.

White Crow by Marcus Sedgwick

Rebecca moves with her father from London to a small, seaside village, where she befriends another motherless girl and they spend the summer together exploring the village's sinister history.

The Loners by Lex Thomas

When a virus deadly to adults infects their high school, brothers David and Will and the other students soon break into gangs that fight each other for survival and the hope of escaping their quarantine.

The Waking Dark by Robin Wasserman

After a series of suicide-killings, the residents start acting even more strangely than would be expected. Only the 5 witnesses of the murders retain their sound minds, and must band together to save the town from whatever has come over it.

In the Shadow of Black Birds by Cat Winters

As influenza and World War I take their toll, Mary watches desperate mourners flock to séances for comfort. Despite her scientific leanings, she must consider if ghosts are real when her first love, killed in battle, returns.

The Watcher in the Shadows by Carlos Ruiz Zafón
