Arrest Warrant Scam



Common Victims: Anyone (Seniors)

Method of Contact: Telephone

In these scams, scammers make unsolicited telephone calls to citizens (oftentimes seniors) claiming to be law enforcement officials. Citizens are told they have outstanding arrest warrants with specified bond amounts and must send money to various websites to avoid immediate arrest. The scammers are now providing legitimate names and information of law enforcement employees making them seem credible. **DO NOT** send money – call your local law enforcement agency to report this scam. No law enforcement agency will call you and demand payment of a warrant.
