4. What is the amount of damages the Plaintiff Michael Young proved by a preponderance of the evidence were caused by Officer Stephens' conduct? If you answered Question No. 1 "Yes" but Mr. Young has not proved damages, you should award nominal damages in the amount of One Dollar.
