

Fall Recruitment: Loveland Planning Commission

The City of Loveland is accepting applications for the Planning Commission. One or more vacancies are anticipated at the end of 2019. The Commission has a central role in determining how Loveland will grow and develop. To be eligible for the Commission, you must be a City resident. Eligible candidates are encouraged to apply.

Planning Commission Overview:

The 9-member Planning Commission reviews planning policies, land use plans and certain development applications. In some instances, Commission decisions are final; in other instances, recommendations are forwarded to the City Council. Over the past few years that the Commission has been instrumental in guiding development and approving the [Comprehensive Plan](#), the [Highway 287 Strategic Plan](#), and the [Unified Development Code](#). These documents and future plans have far-reaching impacts on Loveland's growth and development.

Number of Commission Positions Available:

One or more vacancies are anticipated being in January of 2020.

Is there a designated term for service?

Term lengths are 3 years, unless the appointment is to fill a partial term.

What is the schedule for Planning Commission meetings?

The Commission has regularly scheduled meetings on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month. Meetings begin at 6:30 p.m. and occasionally run until 8:00 or 9:00 p.m. Meetings are canceled when no business is scheduled. Additional study sessions may occur when major policy and code documents are under consideration.

1. **Applications must be submitted by November 1, 2019 at 5:00 PM.**
