The City of Loveland hosts a public workshop for Mehaffey Park.

The public is invited to a workshop for the design of Mehaffey Community Park. The Parks and Recreation Department will host a public meeting to discuss design concepts on December 15, 2011. The workshop will be held at the Police Institute, 810 East 10th Street, Loveland CO. The workshop will be from 6:30 to 8:30 P.M. Please enter the building from the east side.

Mehaffey Park is a 60 acre community park planned for construction next year to serve the west side of Loveland. Mehaffey Park is located west of Wilson Avenue, north of 22nd Street and south of 29th Street. The workshop will start with a brief presentation and be followed by small group discussions regarding design alternatives prepared by AECOM. A preferred plan will be refined over the next few weeks for a future open house on January 19, 2012 to review the final master plan.

The consultant team has been working on site analysis and concept plans for the Park since early November. The design process will include several open houses, scheduled to occur over the winter, for public review and comment. Master planning of the park should be completed in early February and construction of the park will start next summer. The property will be annexed and platted during the master planning and development review process.
