The City of Loveland hosts a public workshop for HP/Agilent Open Space.

The public is invited to a workshop for the design of HP/Agilent Open Space. The Parks and Recreation Department will host a public meeting to discuss design concepts on February 29, 2012. The workshop will be held at the Chilson Senior Center, 700 E. Fourth Street, Loveland, CO 80537. The workshop will be from 6:30 to 8:30 pm. Please enter the building through the Senior Center.

HP/Agilent Open Space is a 121-acre site planned for development in fall 2012. The property is located south of 1st Street and west of Railroad Avenue. The workshop will start with a brief presentation and be followed by small group discussions regarding design alternatives prepared by AECOM. A preferred plan will be refined over the next few weeks for a future open house in early April to review the final master plan.

The consultant team has been working on site analysis and concept plans for the HP/Agilent Open Space since early January. The design process will include several open houses for public review and comment. Master planning of the open space will be completed in late spring and development should begin next fall.
