

## **“Fall in Loveland Car Show” Rules & Regulations**

- ♥ ***No alcoholic beverages will be permitted. Violators may be ticketed/removed from the premises.***
- ♥ Car Show registrations must be completed between 10:00am and 12:00pm.
- ♥ All Vehicles will be classified by the vehicle owner at the time of registration.  
Please look closely at the Registration Form for the place to choose the class(es) you would like to enter your car, truck, or motorcycle into for judging.
- ♥ ***Judging will begin at 12:00 noon.***  
***Please have all show vehicles detailed and ready to be judged by that time.***  
***Late entries will not be permitted.***
- ♥ All display materials must be anchored safely. Failure to comply with this may disqualify your entry, and you may be asked to remove items that fly around.
- ♥ Vehicle Identification Cards must be clearly displayed on all show vehicles in the dash area/front windshield. ***Vehicles without entry cards will NOT be judged!***
- ♥ Judging will be based upon the INTERNATIONAL CAR SHOW ASSOCIATION (I.C.S.A.) judging standards. Please see the judging sheets for further information.  
All entries will be judged with attention to detail, cleanliness, and overall appearance.  
Entries will be judged as fairly and impartially as possible.
- ♥ Car Show awards will include 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place trophies for each class, plus one each of Best in Show, Best Interior, Best I.C.E, and Best Wheels trophies.  
ALL cars registered for the show are eligible for the “Best of Show” trophy. The winner of “Best in Show” is not eligible for any other trophy awards.
- ♥ No vehicles will be moved once they are parked on the show lot, unless a staff member asks specifically for a vehicle to be moved. This is for safety reasons with the crowds/children present at the show.
- ♥ No vehicle will be judged if their sound system exceeds acceptable noise levels. These noise levels may be determined by the City of Loveland Police ordinances for sound levels in a public park.  
Audio and visual systems may be utilized at low levels throughout the day, or to demonstrate to judges for a limited time period during which the vehicle is being evaluated.
- ♥ Judges must have access to all areas of the vehicle, including the trunk, interior, or engine compartment if the participant wishes to be judged for that area. Judges are not to touch or open any areas of the vehicle to complete their judging duties, so please have all areas accessible to the judges during that time.
- ♥ It is suggested that you be available to the judges during the time that your vehicle is being evaluated. They may have questions for you, or may need your assistance with your vehicle. However, ***it is NOT required that you talk to the judge unless he/she requests it.***
- ♥ ***All vehicles must remain in the show area during the event hours of 12:00-6:00pm.***  
***WINNERS MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN AWARDS!***  
***If you leave early from the event, you will forfeit your show position and your entry fee, and will not receive the award for your class.***
- ♥ The decision of the judges is final. Revisions will not be made to judging sheets. Tie-breakers will be decided by the head judge after a short re-evaluation of details.
- ♥ Judging staff will be available after the awards ceremony to answer any questions about their specific judging sheet or the reasons for the points given, (in order to promote further understanding of the areas needing improvement).

*The City of Loveland reserves the right to enforce any and all city park rules & regulations in addition to these.*

**PAINT – OVERALL PAINT JOB** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Paint must be even throughout the vehicle to include inside engine & door jambs, etc..
- Should not have scratches or dents that you can easily notice.
- Custom paint must match the entire vehicle inside & out, we will check!  
*(Custom paint does not include any paint job that came from the factory!)*
- Cleanliness overall – Must be clean from top to bottom for full points.

**BODY & EXTERIOR MODIFICATIONS** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Body kits should be mounted correctly and match the vehicles factory look.
- Lights must work and be mounted safely to your vehicle & match the car's scheme.
- Factory or custom grills should match the car and be mounted correctly.
- Dents or scratches should not be seen on entire car!
- Cleanliness overall.

**ENGINE MODIFICATIONS** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Chrome must be clean, not discolored or chipped to include mounting brackets and screws.
- Everything must function properly, turbo, supercharger, & NOS for max points.
- Wiring must be clean & oil free – no dripping of any fluids what so ever.
- Upgrades to include headers, intake, exhaust, throttle body, any extra, etc..
- Cleanliness overall. Must have hood open in full view of the judges before they start!

**SUSPENSION** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Undercarriage must be clean and free of oil & products must be bolted down.
- Chrome needs to be polished & maintained throughout the suspension.
- Bushings & Bearings must be clean under the car, also must function on road.
- Cleanliness overall!

**WHEELS AND TIRES** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Wheels and tires must be clean, judges will check for dirt and grease.
- Lug nuts and rims should match the car style and should be mounted correctly.
- Should all match and have proper rubber (tread) for safe driving.
- Rims should generally follow the color scheme of your car & match your vehicle's style!
- Cleanliness overall!

**INTERIOR MODIFICATIONS** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- All products should be mounted & secured to the vehicle.
- Carpet should be vacuumed inside, no fingerprints or stains on carpet or seats.
- Seat upgrades and dash kits are recommended, (carbon fiber, etc.)
- The color scheme of your car must match with the interior scheme for max points.
- *Seat Covers are not recommended unless they are fit properly, and look correct.*
- Cleanliness overall.

**CAR AUDIO & SECURITY SYSTEM** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Installation must be clean, no wires showing inside of vehicle.
- Should have completed sound system.
- System must be able to play and function when judges ask.
- Alarm system must be installed and working for max points.
- Cleanliness overall.

**AIR INTAKE / EXHAUST**

1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Your vehicle must have air intake and exhaust.
- Intake & exhaust must be mounted and installed correctly on car or truck.
- Should match color scheme of vehicle.
- Filters must be clean for max points (may be checked if a tie breaker).

**TRUNK, HATCHBACK, CABIN, OR BED**

1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Must be open or unlocked before judges arrive to score this area.
- Free of bags, clothes, & personal belongings. Not a storage area.
- Panels or materials must be fitted properly, not missing, hanging, or loose. Should be a proper fit.
- Must be vacuumed & free of dust and dirt. (Judges may shake mats or inspect closely if a tie breaker)
- Cleanliness overall.

**“EXTRA CREDIT POINTS”**

1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Has your car been featured in a magazine before? Show us!
- Should have a photo book of pictures for car or “Battleboard” showing features. Show detail and some work that was done.
- Some type of display can earn a point or two. Where is yours?
- Vehicle must stand out; do something different and special for extra points!!
- Cleanliness overall.

**TOTAL SCORE (Out of 100) \_\_\_\_\_**

There is a possible score of 100 points including the Extra Credit! Remember our judges want to give you the points you deserve, so follow the guidelines above, and be available if the judge needs to ask questions.

**PAINT – OVERALL PAINT JOB** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Should not have scratches or dents that you can easily notice.
- Custom paint must match the entire bike inside & out, we will check!
- Cleanliness overall – Must be clean from top to bottom for full points.

**WHEELS AND TIRES** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Wheels and tires must be clean, judges will check for dirt and grease.
- Rims should match the bike and should be mounted correctly.
- Should all match and have proper rubber (tread) for safe driving.
- Rims should follow the color scheme of your bike & match your cycles style!
- Cleanliness overall!

**ENGINE MODIFICATIONS** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Chrome must be clean, not discolored or chipped to include mounting brackets and screws.
- Everything must function properly, turbo, supercharger, & NOS for max points.
- Engine must be clean & oil free – no dripping of any fluids what so ever.
- Cleanliness overall.

**SUSPENSION** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Undercarriage must be clean and free of oil & products must be bolted down.
- Chrome needs to be polished & maintained throughout the suspension.
- Bike stands or kick stands must match the bike.
- Cleanliness overall!

**“EXTRA CREDIT POINTS”** 1 to 10 Points \_\_\_\_\_

- Has your bike been featured in a magazine before? Show us!
- Should have a photo book of pictures for bike or “Battleboard” showing features. Show detail and some work that was done.
- Some type of display can earn a point or two. Where is yours?
- Bike must stand out with Style & Originality.

**TOTAL SCORE (Out of 50)** \_\_\_\_\_

There is a possible score of 50 points including the Extra Credit! Remember our judges want to give you the points you deserve, so follow the guidelines above, and be available if the judge needs to ask questions.

### **BEST OF SHOW:**

Added “Best” Points 1 to 10 \_\_\_\_\_

*ALL SHOW ENTRIES WILL BE JUDGED IN THIS CATEGORY, BASED ON OVERALL POINTS AWARDED.*

*(This trophy is awarded instead of a 1<sup>st</sup> place award, and cannot be awarded in addition to any other trophy.)*

- Is this vehicle “over and above” others at the show in its class point standings? Total Class Points (above) \_\_\_\_\_
- Has this vehicle shown exemplary workmanship and style that attracts the largest crowds?
- Does this vehicle display an overall “showstopper” quality?
- Does this vehicle belong in magazines, on television, or on a National show circuit in your opinion?

### **BEST DISPLAY:**

Added “Best” Points 1 to 10 \_\_\_\_\_

- Is the appearance of the vehicle better than others due to exceptional points in Cleanliness (above), etc.?
- Does this vehicle have additional pieces set up on or around the vehicle to accentuate certain aspects of the overall display?
- Is there a display theme that the vehicle portrays?
- Does this vehicle display an overall “showstopper” quality in overall appearance?
- Does this vehicle belong in magazines, on television, or on a National show circuit because of its display?

### **BEST I.C.E. (In Car Entertainment):**

Added “Best” Points 1 to 10 \_\_\_\_\_

- Is the entertainment system of the vehicle better than others due to exceptional points in Car Audio (above)?
- Does this vehicle have additional pieces installed to accentuate certain aspects of the overall display?
- Does the I.C.E. of this vehicle attract crowds or entertain people at the show?
- Is there a certain entertainment theme that the vehicle portrays?
- Does this vehicle display an overall “showstopper” quality in audio or visual components?
- Does this vehicle belong in magazines, on television, or on a National show circuit because of its I.C.E.?

### **BEST INTERIOR:**

Added “Best” Points 1 to 10 \_\_\_\_\_

- Is the appearance of the vehicle better than others due to exceptional points in Interior Modifications (above), etc.?
- Does this vehicle have additional interior pieces installed to accentuate certain aspects of the overall display?
- Is there an interior theme that the vehicle portrays? ...and is the interior theme consistent with the exterior theme?
- Does this vehicle display an overall “showstopper” quality in overall interior appearance?
- Does this vehicle belong in magazines, on television, or on a National show circuit because of its interior?

### **BEST WHEELS:**

Added “Best” Points 1 to 10 \_\_\_\_\_

- Is the appearance of the wheels better than others due to exceptional points in Wheels & Tires (above), etc.?
- Does this vehicle have extraordinary wheels or special color matched paint to accentuate certain aspects of the overall display?
- Do the wheels & tires fit properly and maintain the overall style of the vehicle while “standing out” from others?
- If the wheels on this vehicle accentuate the brakes or calipers, do the brakes & calipers also have an exceptional appearance?
- Does this vehicle display a “showstopper” quality in overall exterior appearance due to the wheels & tires?
- Does this vehicle belong in magazines, on television, or on a National show circuit because of its wheels & tires?

# TOP 10 SHOW-WINNING TIPS

## TIPS FOR THE SHOW FROM THE LIPS OF THOSE WHO KNOW

### 10. **If you're not going to do something right, don't do it at all.**

That's right. Execution is everything. Thinking about installing a monster air scoop on your carbon fiber hood? Forget it unless you have enough resources to make the final product look perfect. Please spare the judges the frightening sight of haphazard Bondo work, nasty glue residue, or fabrication asymmetry. It's just not worth it.

### 9. **Make the car a stud, not a scud.**

The better a car looks, the more attention one pays to it. If you want to attract the attention of the judges, your car's "at-a-first-glance" appearance must be up to par. And if you want to keep their attention, the finer details must be there as well.

### 8. **Be subtle. Don't reveal all of your cards at once.**

Build your car so only a more astute observer will notice the smaller details such as a slight color change or a mild fender flare. Most observers, judges included, don't always like to be spoon-fed with details. If you make them work a little bit, they will more likely appreciate what they find. However, if you make them work too hard, they'll ignore your work, quickly lose interest, and walk away.

### 7. **Keep your distance; don't get jaded.**

Often, a builder gets a bit near-sighted when it comes to judging his own creation. This tendency to over-appreciate one's work is the downfall of many artists. Whether it may be a particular piece of bodywork that you spent a lot of time working on or a mystical pearl paint job that cost you an arm and a leg, don't let your efforts color your perspective.

### 6. **Woman are people, not decorations.**

While it may be awfully tempting to have bikini-clad woman sprawled over your show car, don't expect to earn any brownie points with the judges. While there's no doubt that beautiful ladies attract their attention, they do so by taking it away from your car! Not to mention the fact that having whistling men surrounding your car makes it difficult for the judges to get a close look (at the car, that is).

### 5. **Presentation is everything.**

When it comes to displays, be as creative as possible. The right display, whether it is as extravagant as a neon backlit hydraulically actuated platform, or as simple as a well-placed smoke machine, can add a big impact to your overall appearance. While display may not be worth any hard points from the judges, the right one can make a nice-looking car look better.

### 4. **A winning car must look great from every imaginable angle.**

Judges pride themselves for their ability to find flaws by looking in the deepest recesses of your car. Don't let them win. Be creative. With a flashlight, look in every nook and cranny of your car to find and eliminate even the slightest imperfection. It would be a shame if a single rusted bolt head, nestled in your fender well, kept your otherwise perfect car from taking home a prize.

### 3. **Make bolt-on's look like they weren't simply bolted on.**

This applies to electronics as well. A show car should look well thought out, with all of its modifications carefully integrated to its surroundings. Having something simply bolted on to the engine or screwed into the dashboard looks crude. Don't be afraid to spice things up by fabricating an attractive mounting bracket or a custom holder. Remember that there will be other cars with the similar or same, modifications as yours. Distinguish yourself! It's your only chance.

### 2. **Keep your eyes, ears and mind open.**

Listen to what the judges say and try to learn from it. If a judge says that your car is too distracting and dissonant, find out what he means before assuming that he doesn't know what he is talking about. It's as important to learn from others, as it is to figure things out for yourself. It saves time as well as money.

### 1. **Have fun! Remember, it's only a car show.**

While driving home with a fat check in your back pocket or a trophy is nice, don't get obsessed with winning. In the long run, the friends that you make and the people who you positively influence will be the real prize.
